PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

On Thursday, March 16th, the Pritzker Military Library will host Medal of Honor recipient, Paul Bucha for a one-on-one interview with executive director Ed Tracy as part of the library's Medal of Honor series. The event is free and open to the public.

In March 1968, in the weeks following the Tet Offensive, Captain Bucha and his company found themselves surrounded and cutoff by a North Vietnamese Army battalion. In the days that followed, Bucha lead an extraordinary offensive against overwhelming odds to combat the enemy and in so doing received the nation's highest military award, the Medal of Honor.

The two-time All American swimmer and graduate of West Point, returned to teach there before embarking on a successful business and entrepreneurial career, which included a term as President of the Congressional Medal of Honor Society.

The Pritzker Military Library is Chicago's newest military research facility, offering over 16,000 volumes and 300 prints and posters. The Library presents weekly author lectures, interviews and panel discussions to a live audience and exhibits military art and antique posters from its collection. All lectures and panel discussions are web cast with a live audience and archived on the website for future viewing at pritzkermilitarylibrary.org.
